This insurance excludes trips booked or commenced against medical advice or after receipt of a terminal prognosis or for the purpose of obtaining medical treatment or convalescent care.

It also excludes claims for medical conditions or other circumstances known to the Insured Person at the time that the trip was booked or the insurance was effected whichever was the later.

If at any time you are in doubt about the relevance of these or any other exclusions mentioned herein, clarification should be sought from Underwriters.

THIS ADDITIONAL INSURANCE IS ONLY AVAILABLE WITH THE TRAVEL PACKAGE INSURANCE

- **Section A)** **Covers your RALLY DEPOSIT/FEES and CREW FEES prior to the start of the rally.**

- **Section B)** Standard travel insurance will only pay for repatriation back to your place of domicile, it will not pay for costs associated with your return to the boat, therefore this extension :
Covers the cost of REJOINING THE RALLY following a medical repatriation claim,

OUTLINE BENEFITS OF THE INSURANCE:-

Section A)

Cancellation and Loss of Deposit and or rally fees for Owner of vessel

The cost of the rally is £ 10,750 per skipper and 1 crew with £500 per additional crewmember. To protect the cost of the rally you will require cancellation cover as follows.

To reimburse the Boat Owner/Entrant in respect of pre-paid and irrecoverable registration fees and/or entry fees and/or crew supplements which are forfeited following withdrawal from the Event prior to the start for any fortuitous cause beyond the Owner's control and not otherwise specifically excluded.

Section B)

Rejoining the rally

The insurance will reimburse you for your reasonable costs in rejoining the Rally at a suitable point of call following repatriation in accordance with the cover provided under Section 2 Medical Repatriation and Other Expenses.

Maximum sum Insured £3,000 per person

SECTION B)	Cost per person
Maximum sum Insured £3,000 per person	£175 per person

Inclusive of 17.5% Insurance premium Tax

Main Exclusions applicable to this extension:-

- 1) Financial circumstances of any kind.
- 2) Any circumstances known at the time of effecting the insurance which could reasonably be expected to give rise to a claim.
- 3) Any pre-existing medical or physical condition.
- 4) Disinclination to continue in the Event.
- 5) War or terrorist actions unless the additional premium has been pre-paid.
- 6) The failure of, or the fear of failure of, or the inability of any equipment or any computer programme to recognise, interpret correctly or process any date as its true calendar date or to continue to function correctly beyond that date.
